

**THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE  
SHERWOOD IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT  
February 7, 2012**

The regular meeting of the Sherwood Improvement District was held on Tuesday, February 7, 2012, at 6910 SW Fountaintale Road, Topeka, Kansas. Board members present were George Schuler, Rick Nesbitt and Bob Gast.

**OLD BUSINESS:**

Kevin Holland reported on the following:

- Weather has been good for the city's water line work within the district.
  - Concern is with the water shut off value at 37<sup>th</sup> and Indian Hills Road. A 2" overlay should take care of the situation.
  - Grass seed and hay is down in the area, which will help with erosion.
- New road project bids will be ready for the next meeting.
- Sand removal to be addressed at a later time.
- Dirt work from 2011 contracts will begin in about a month.
- Eight signs are to be replaced within the district.
- 3 or 4 drainage issues are set to receive bids for work.

**NEW BUSINESS:**

Rich Eckert and Tom Vlach attended to speak to the concerns of the house on 33<sup>rd</sup> Street that board members have received complaints regarding the condition of the property. Kevin asked if it is possible for the improvement district to hire Shawnee County to help with any process it might use to address this concern. Rich Eckert answered in the affirmative.

Kevin also inquired about the county helping with erosion control issues within the district. Mr. Eckert informed him a letter should be sent to him addressing the issues.
